CUB CAMP

The Cub Camp is for the younger player (ages 6-12) or the first time player. Instruction will focus on throwing, catching, hitting, infield and outfield play.

Campers will be grouped by experience and skill level. Each camper will receive a t-shirt.

LIONESS CAMP

The Lioness Camp is for the experienced player ages 12-18. Players will be grouped by experience and skill level. Age exceptions may be made with the understanding that no special accommodations will be made for campers outside of the above age group.

Instruction will focus on throwing, catching, fielding, hitting, infield and outfield play. Specific position skill work will be done in the afternoon sessions. Positions include first base, second base, third base, short stop and outfield.
